

Cottage Grove – Sidewalk Mapping

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This project aims to create a full picture of the state of sidewalks in Cottage Grove West and Central – the portions of Cottage Grove that are west of TC Jester, north of I-10, and south of the Union Pacific railway that divides Cottage Grove and Timbergrove.

Cottage Grove is host to original and midcentury homes, countless new townhomes, and several commercial and industrial businesses. Because of the area's history and patchwork development, sidewalks are incomplete or missing in many areas.

As a result of residents concerned for pedestrian safety, a mapping exercise was undertaken in late 2020 to gather data on the condition of the sidewalks in this area. Now the mapping is complete, and here are the results.

The data show that there are major pedestrian safety issues in this neighborhood. People lack the ability to walk safely alongside roads that are very narrow, filled with parked cars, and considered thoroughfares for fast-moving traffic and large vehicles (including 18-wheelers).

The data is organized in a grid format, and each piece of the grid that was walked is assigned a letter and number. Colors indicate where sidewalks exist (green), do not exist (red), are in bad shape (yellow), and are in development due to new construction (purple).

The first map presents the street grid with map key, and it can be used to refer to its corresponding page, labeled in Letter-Number format in the upper right corner of each grid page.

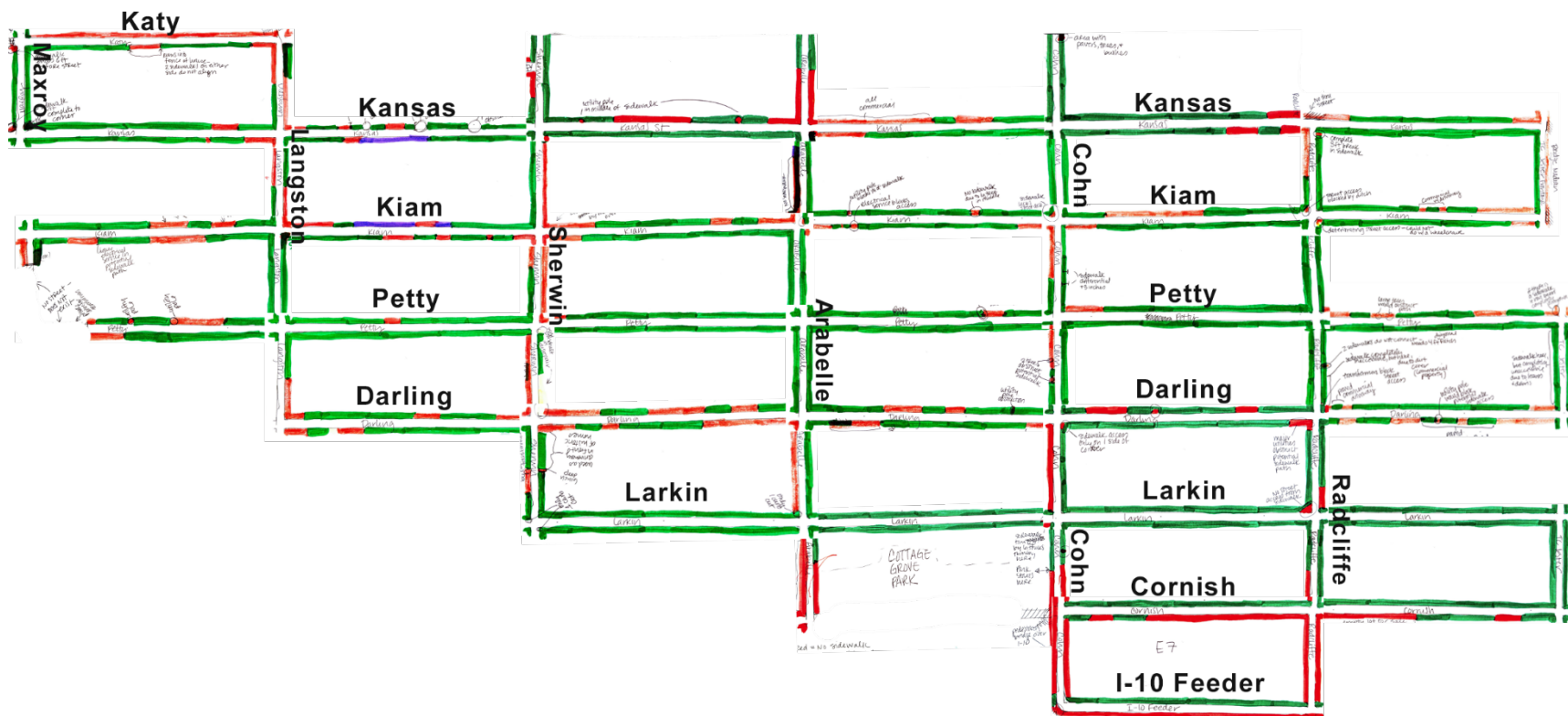

Cottage Grove Sidewalk Mapping Overall Data

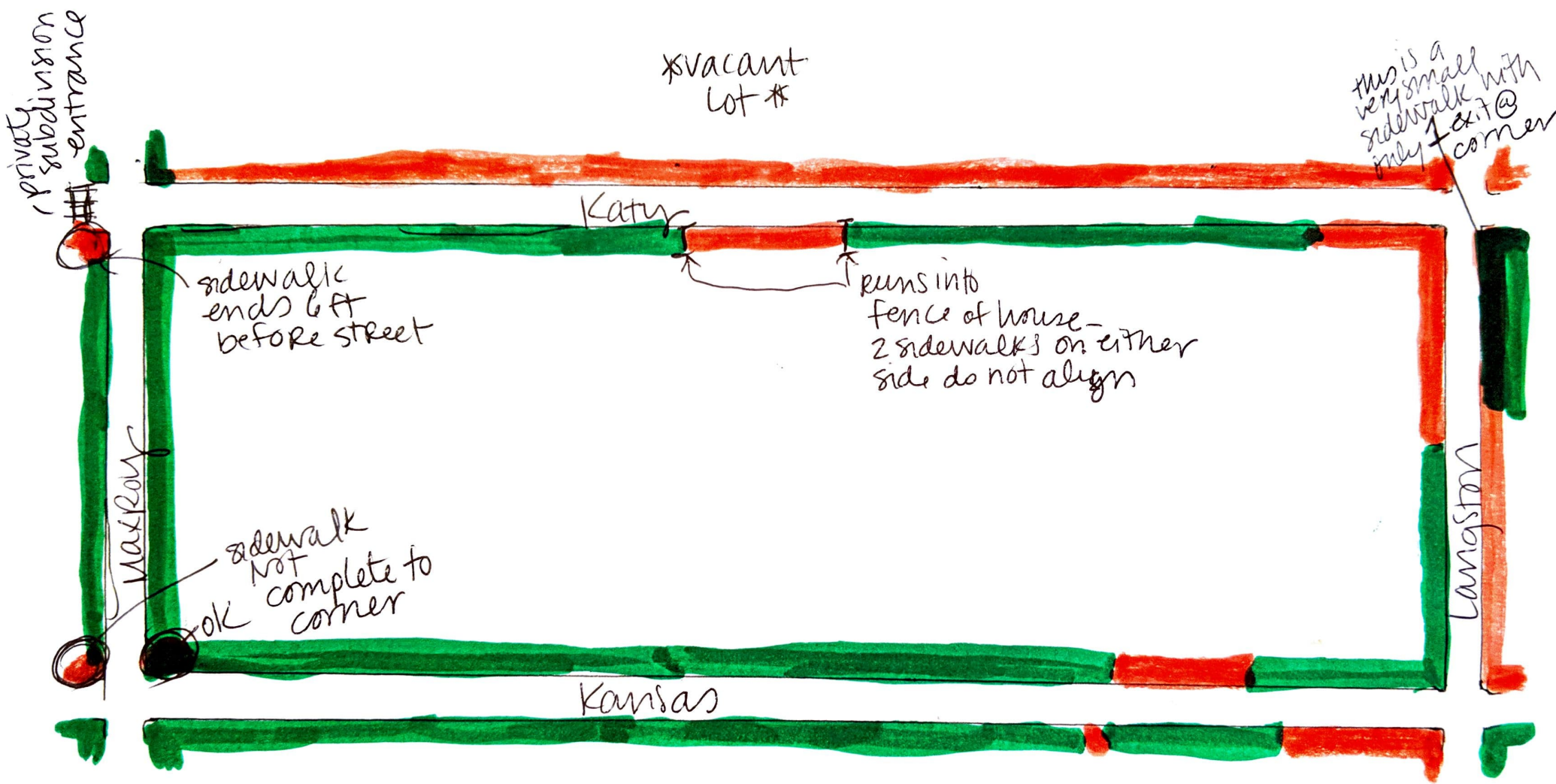

Colors indicate the state of the sidewalks: Present in good condition (green); No sidewalk (red); sidewalk in poor condition (yellow); in development due to new construction (purple). Note the patchwork condition of almost every block in Cottage Grove, with few new sidewalks in development:

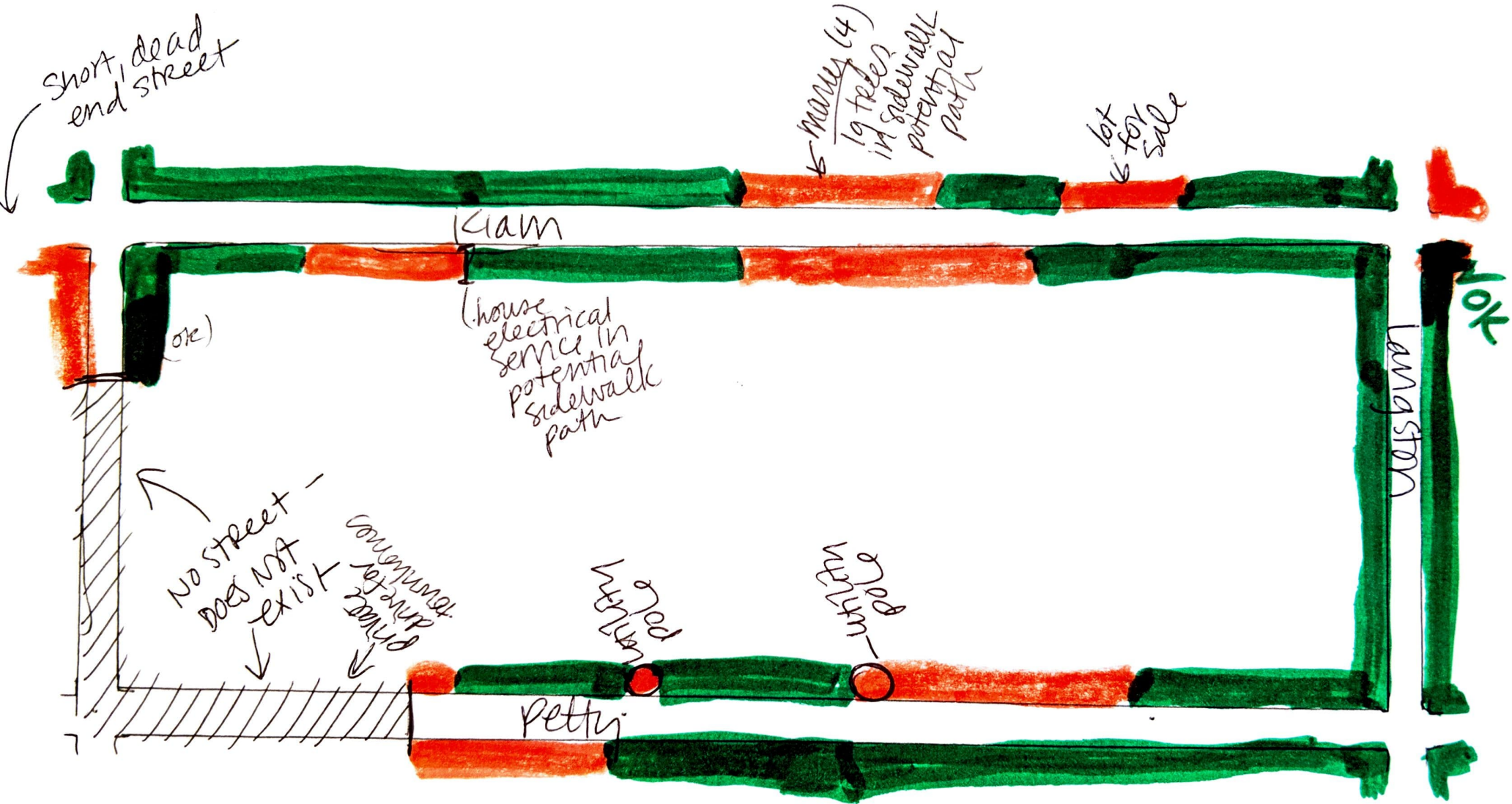


Red = No sidewalk

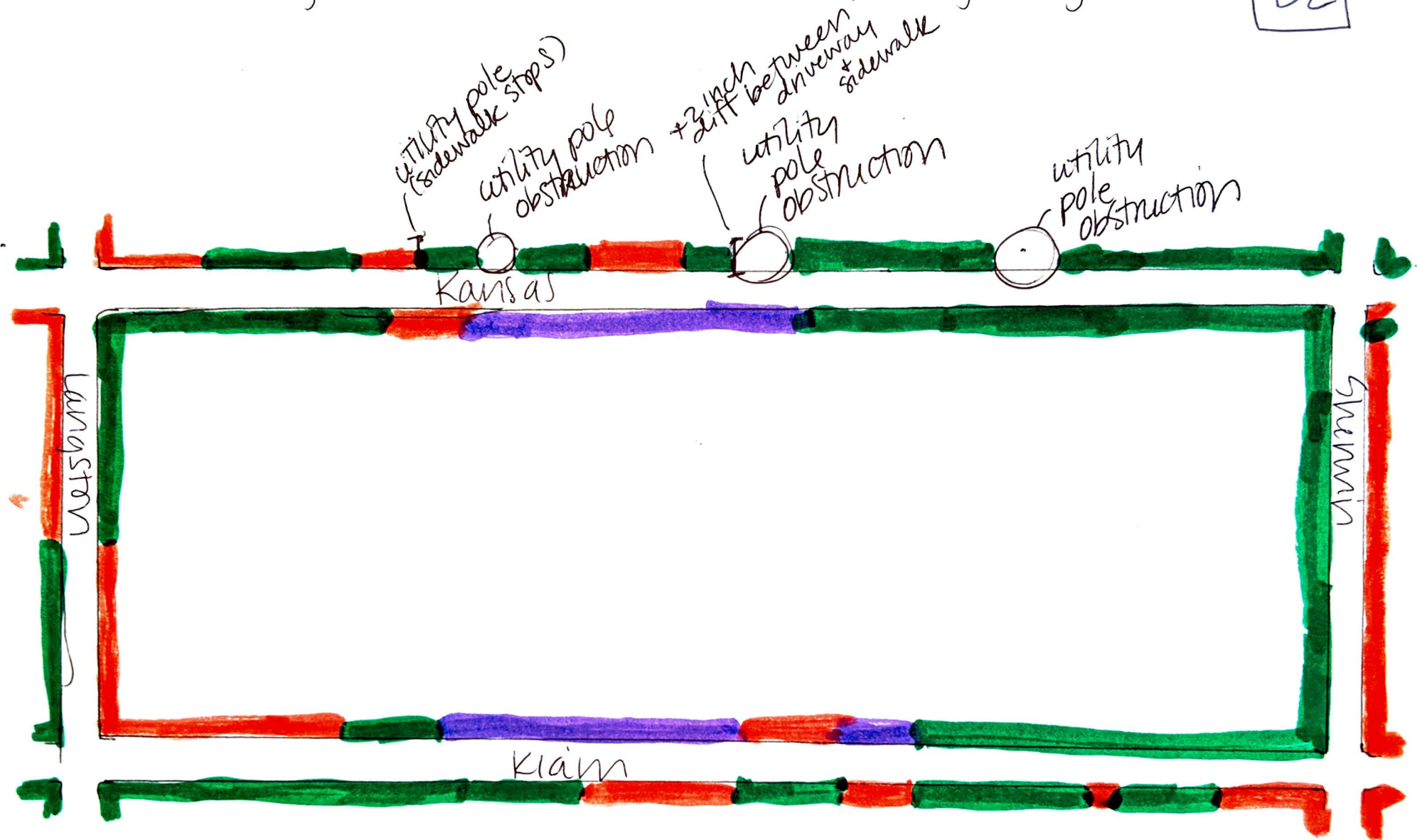

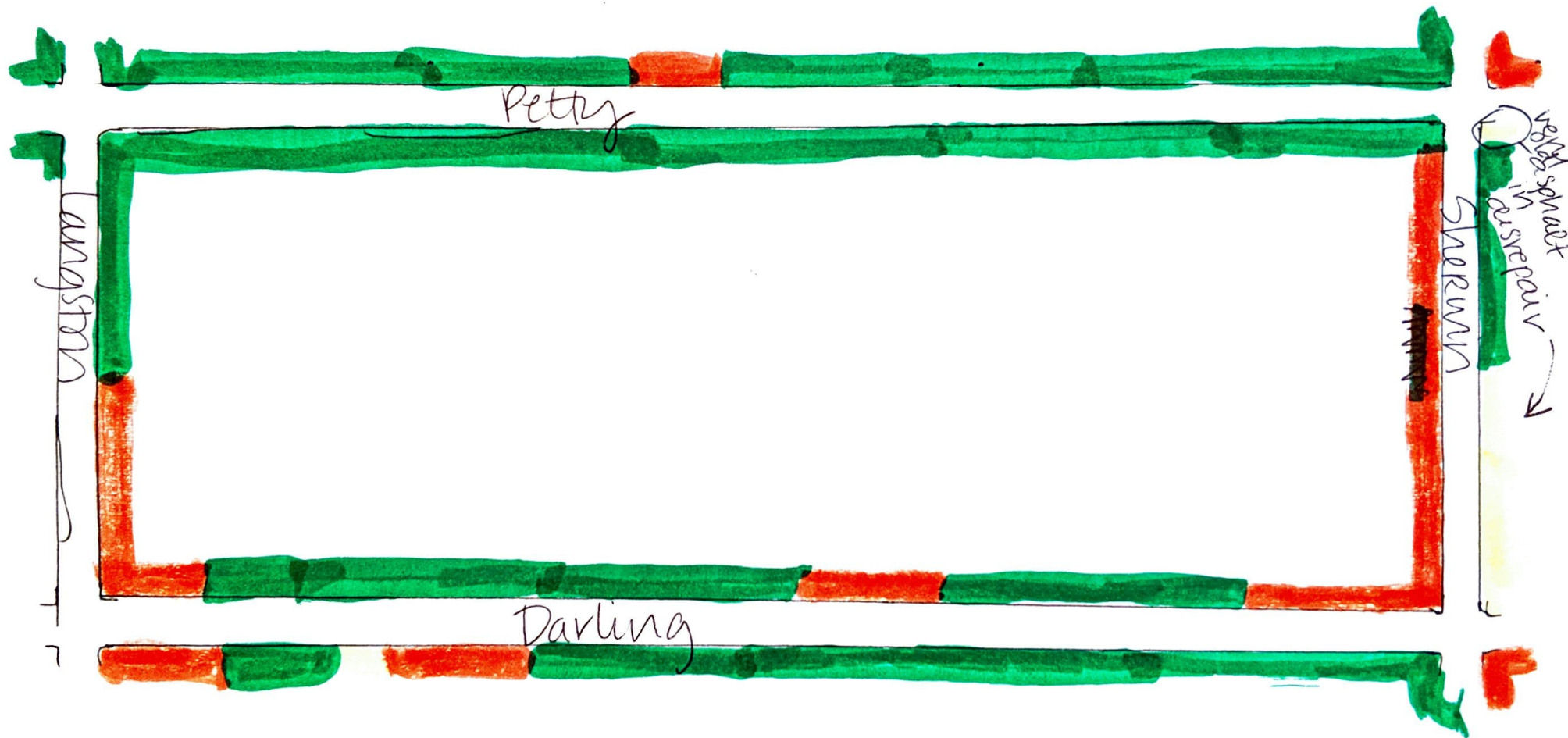

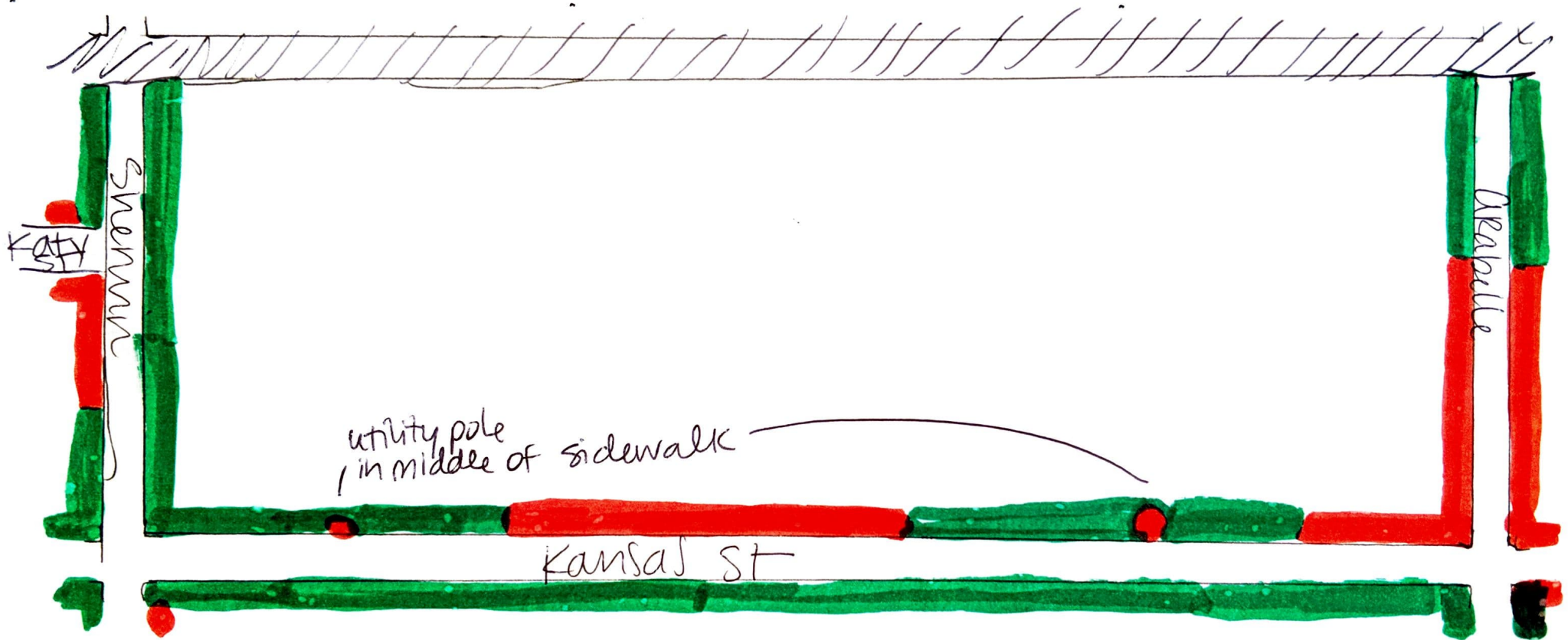

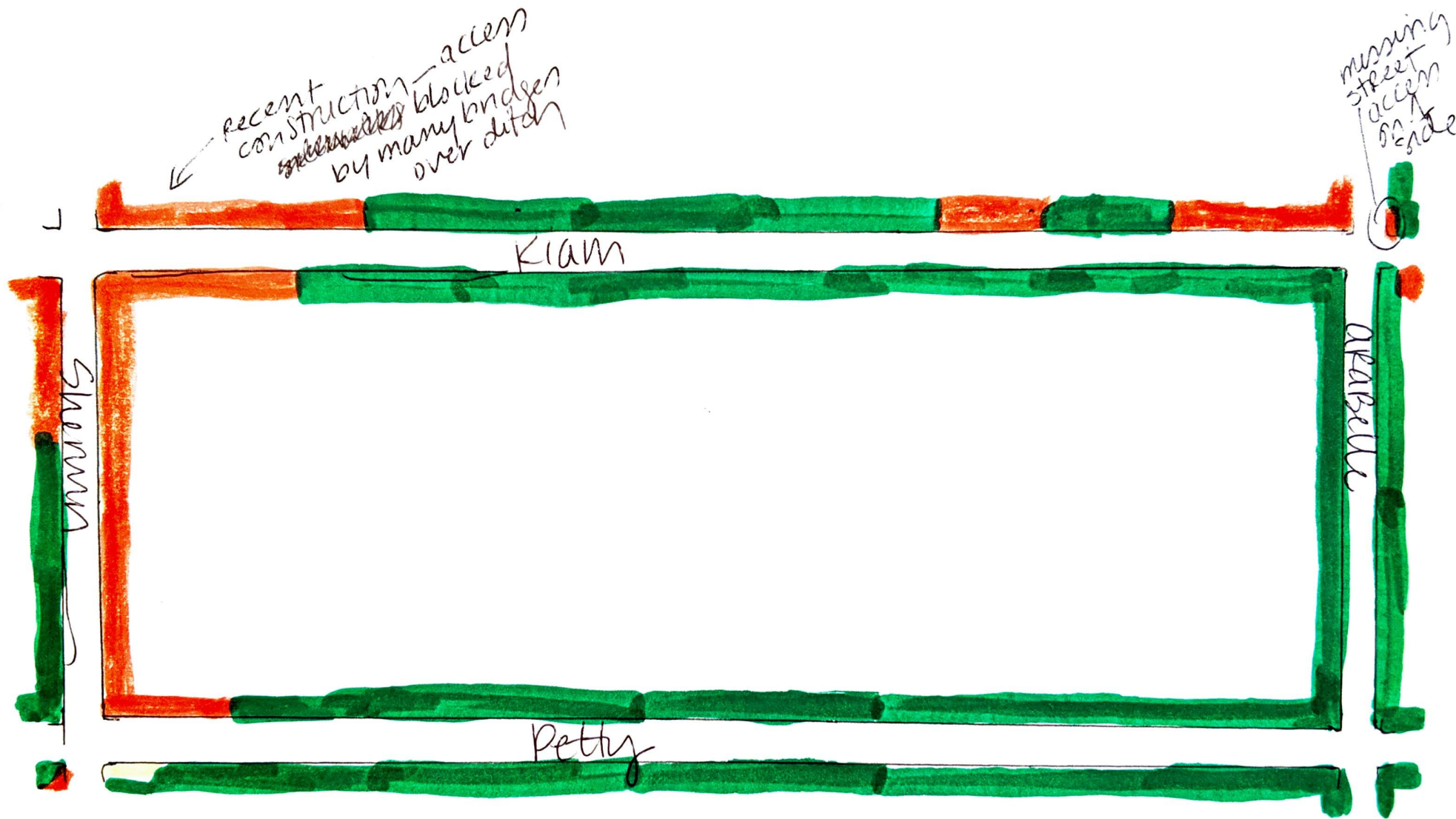

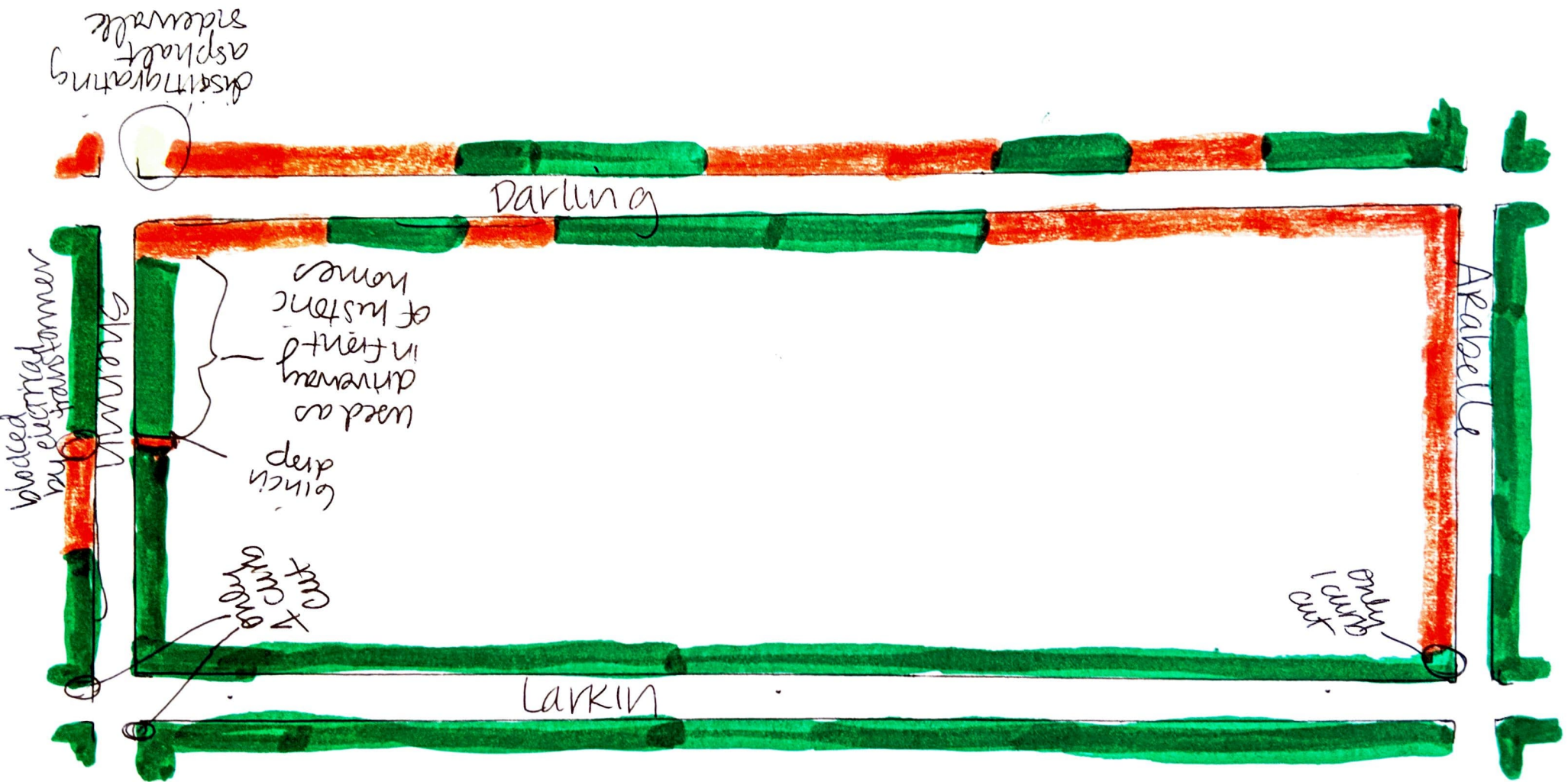

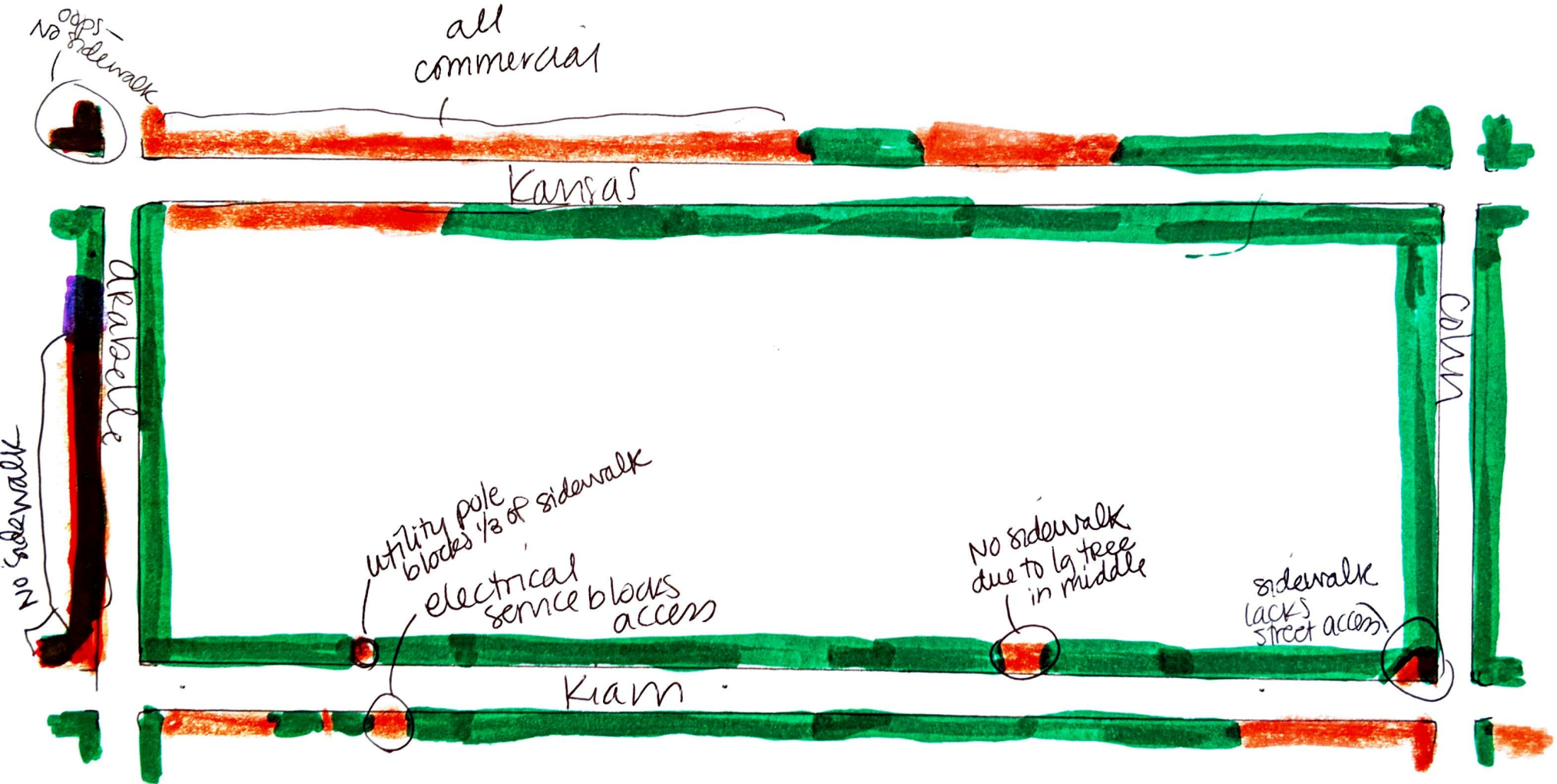

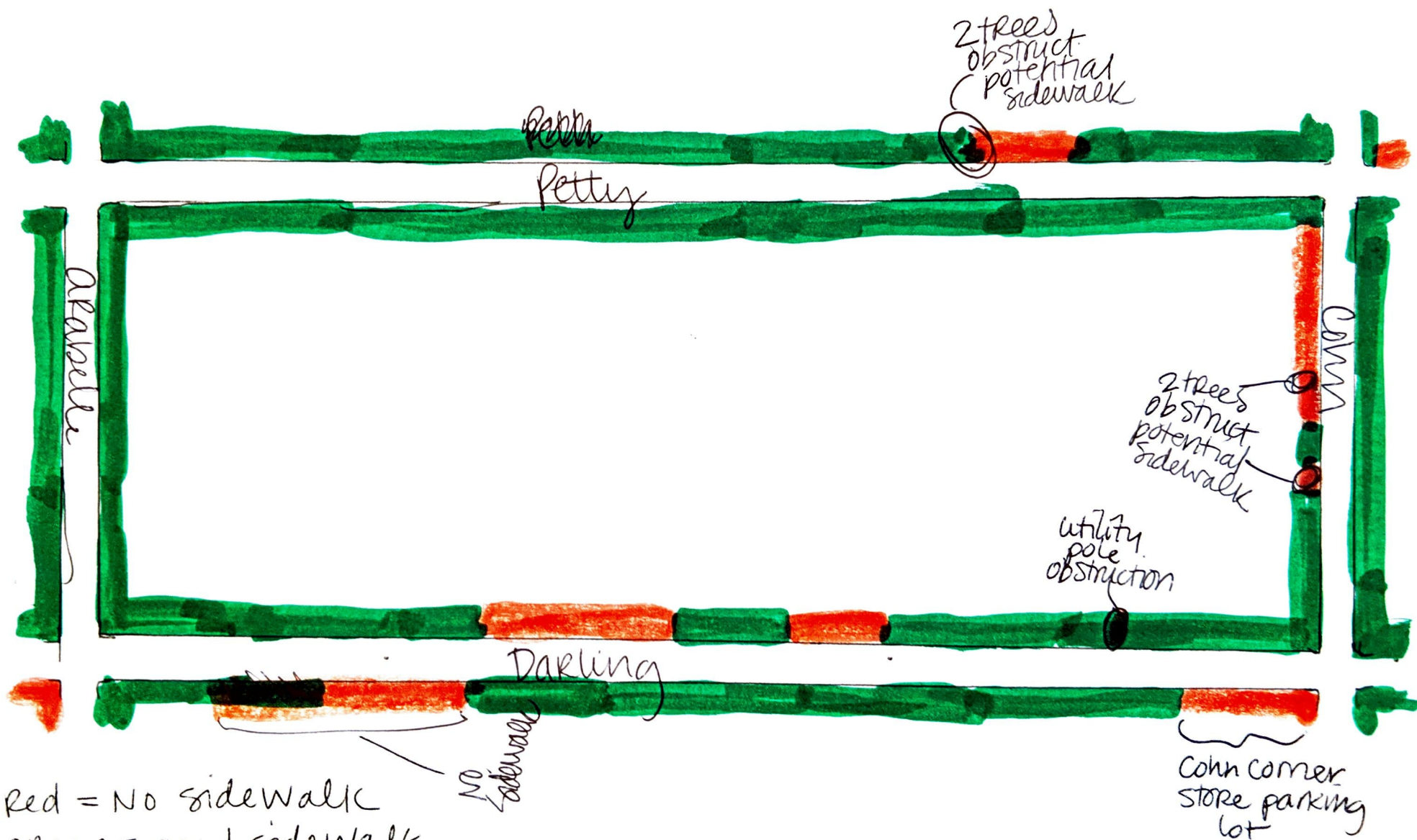

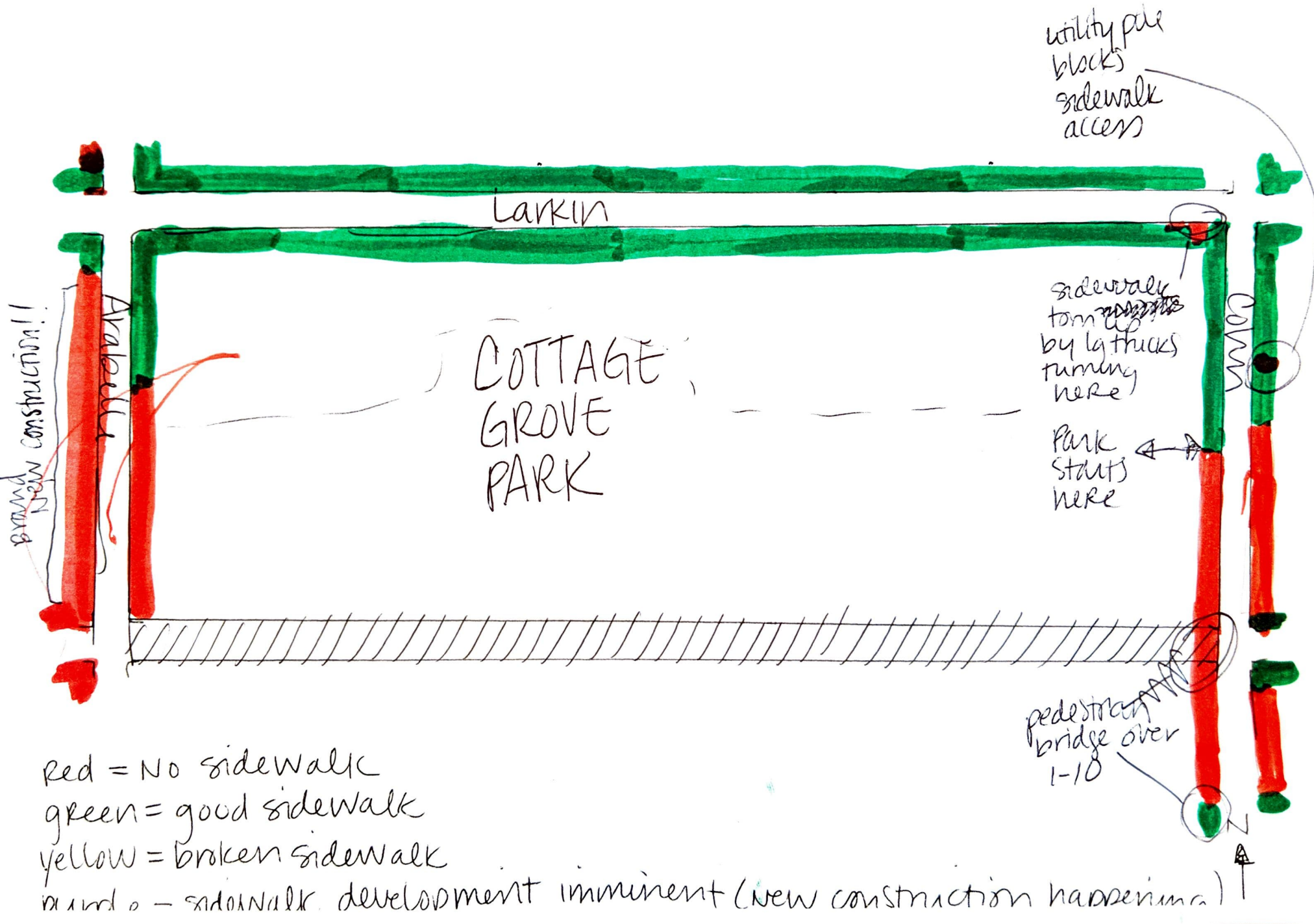

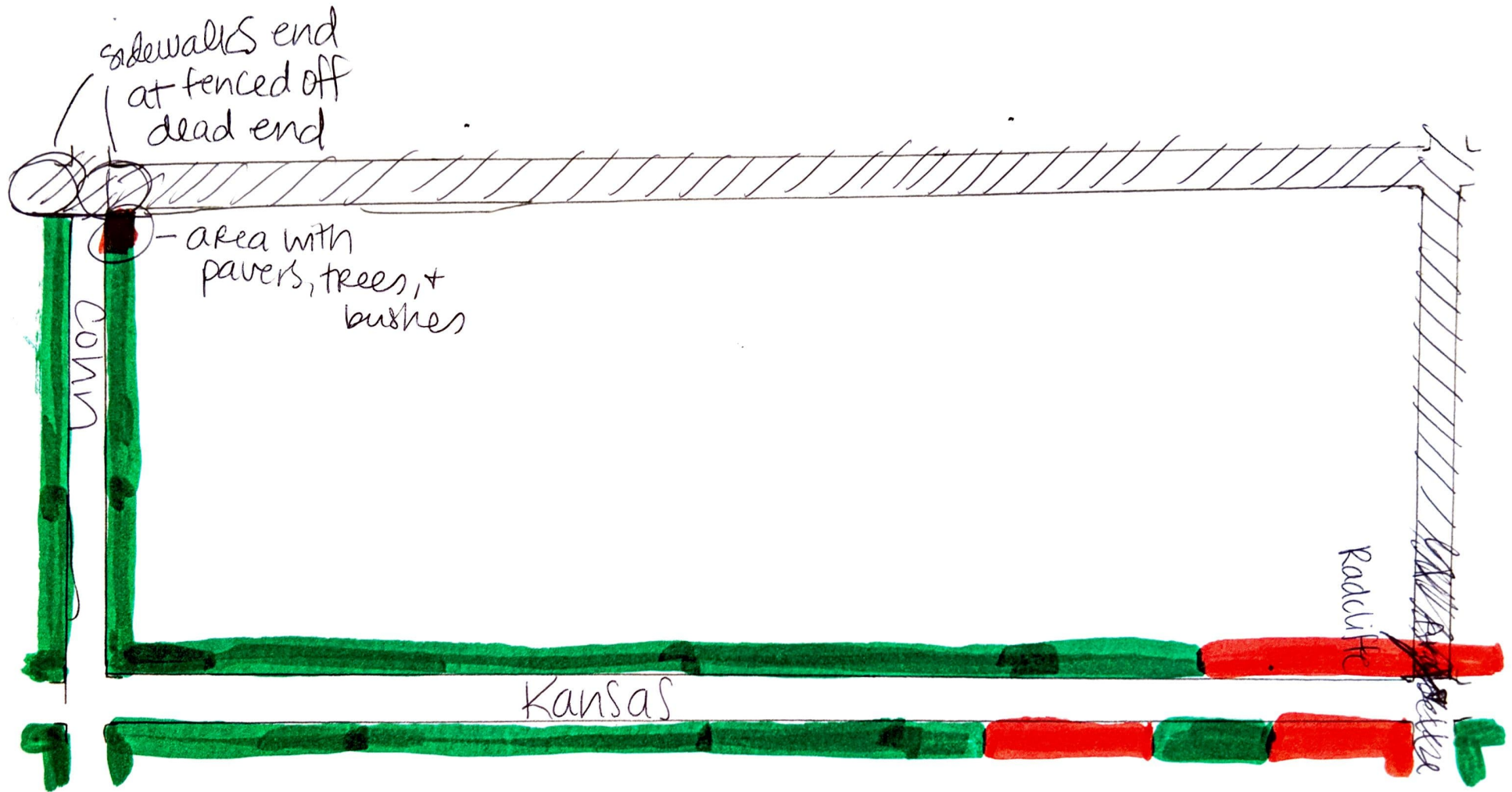

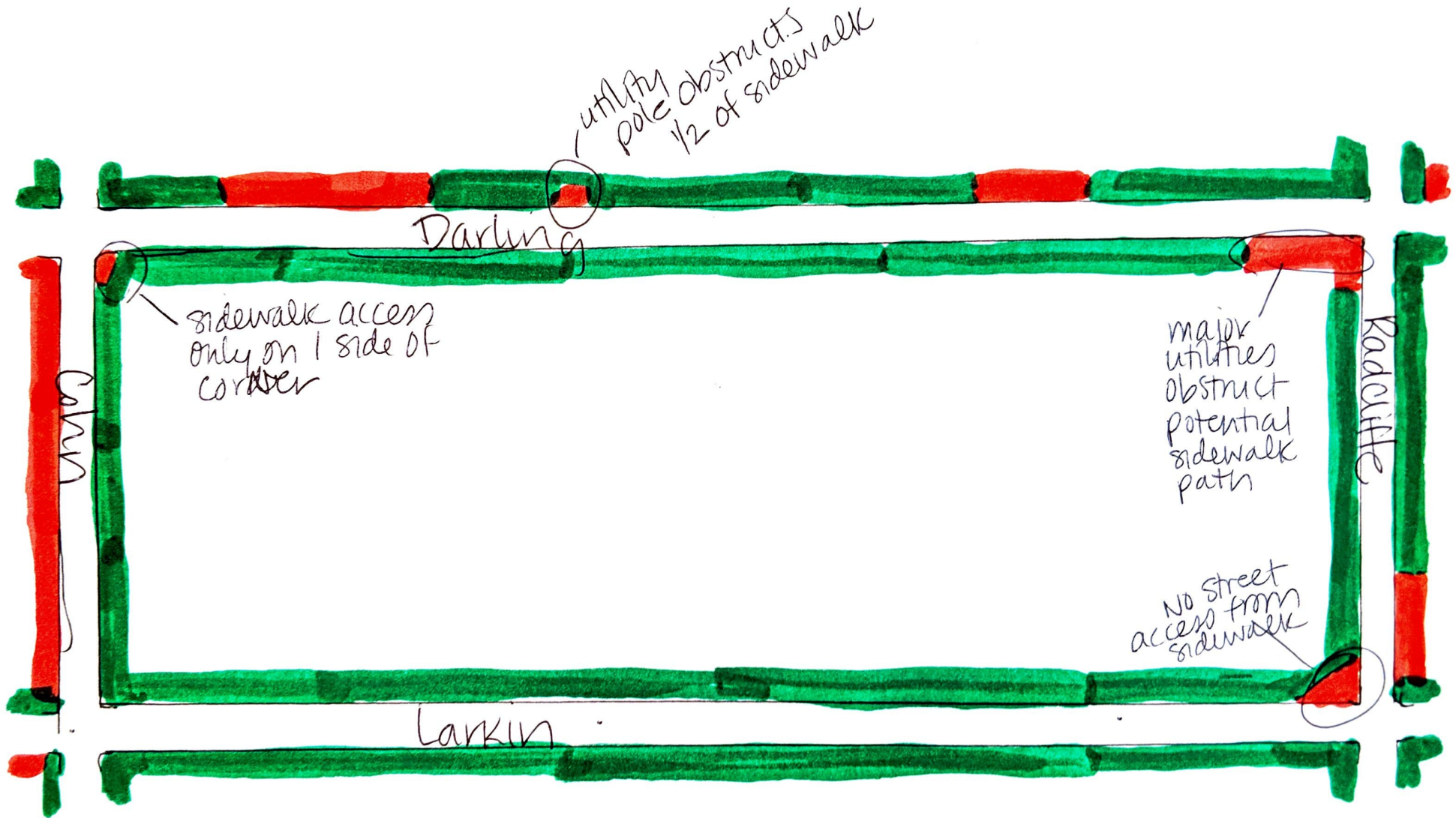

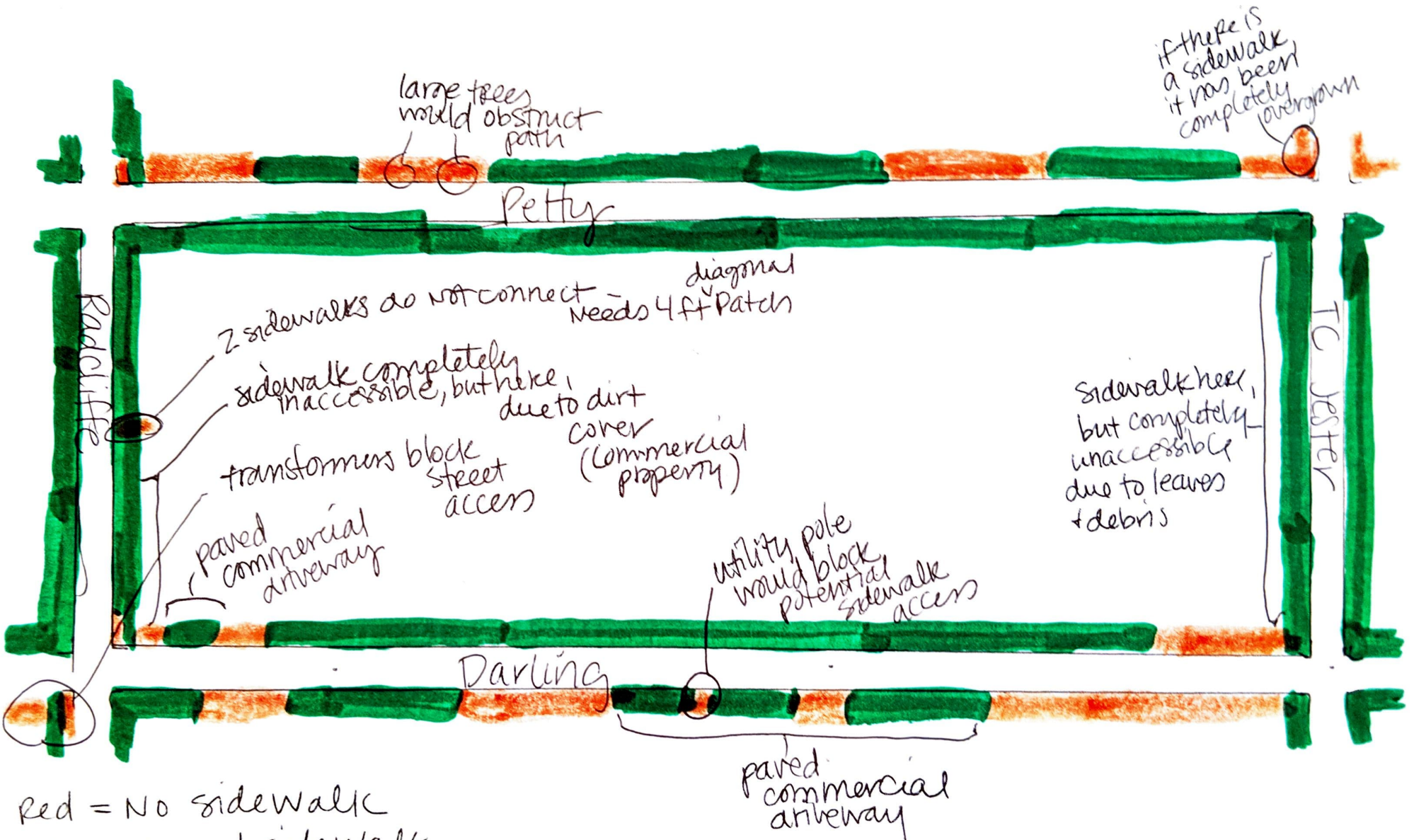
